



## Call for Nominations

### 2010 Governor's Heritage Preservation Honor Awards

The Arizona Preservation Foundation and the State Historic Preservation Office/ Arizona State Parks invite your nominations for the annual Governor's Heritage Preservation Honor Awards. Each year ten awards are given to individuals, businesses, organizations, and/or projects in recognition of outstanding achievements in preserving Arizona's prehistoric and historic resources.

The mission of the Governor's Heritage Preservation Honor Award is to:

- Promote public awareness of historic preservation in the state of Arizona;
- Publicly recognize the varied contributions by volunteers, professionals, organizations, and agencies to promote the goals of historic preservation;
- Identify and recognize educational, community, non-profit, and private-sector heritage projects that demonstrate excellence in design and execution.

This year, presentation of the awards will take place on Friday, May 14, 2010, at a special lunch to be held in conjunction with the Eighth Annual Arizona Historic Preservation Partnership Conference at the Du Bois Center at Northern Arizona University in Flagstaff, Arizona.

While there are no specific categories, nominations can address any aspect of heritage preservation achievement including:

- **Projects:** restoration, rehabilitation, stabilization/ residential, commercial, or public;
- **Individuals:** for a singular or life-time contribution;
- **Businesses** that have shown outstanding professionalism or skill;
- **Organizations or communities:** recognizing their contribution to preservation efforts;
- **Education programs or activities** aimed at increasing awareness of prehistoric and historic resources.

### Selection of Honor Awards and Grand Award

A panel of judges representing the fields of archaeology, architecture, history, and preservation will review the nominations. Ten Honor Award winners will be chosen and announced before the conference; the Grand Award will be chosen from among these ten and announced at the luncheon.

Additional documentation may be requested from nominees of those winners, including professional biographical information, an expanded description of the project, a list of project participants, and additional photos and/or slides.

## Submission Requirements

### 2010 Governor's Heritage Preservation Honor Awards

#### **Nominations must include the following:**

1. **SIX** Copies of the completed nomination form (see page 3).
2. A minimum of one page narrative statement supporting why such recognition should be given. This narrative should briefly identify the scope of the nominee's (individual/organization/project) achievement in the field of historic preservation. It should also provide clear support for the exceptional quality of the nominee's preservation efforts (in terms of community and/or economic development, scientific and/or historic research, innovation in preservation and/or planning). The impact of the nominee's work should further be discussed in terms of its long-term impact on the preservation of Arizona's heritage.
3. Photographs, especially "before" and "after" shots of projects, must be included to aid in judging the nomination and recognize the award recipients in the awards presentation, press materials, and website. Adequate supportive information, such as additional narrative, may also be included to convey the importance of the accomplishment to be nominated.

#### **Format of supportive materials**

High-quality digital submissions of visual materials are encouraged because a visual presentation of the award winners will be shown at the awards luncheon. Submit digital images on a CD-ROM or DVD-R in TIFF or JPEG format. Include a reference page with file names and descriptions for photos.

If submitting photographs, they must be a minimum of 4x6 inches and mounted on an 8.5x11 inch page. Photographs may be either color or black-and-white. All photographs must be clearly labeled with the nominee's name/title, as well as with brief explanations of what is being shown.

All submitted materials will become the property of the Arizona State Historic Preservation Office and will not be returned.

Completed nominations and support material must be received by regular mail or hand delivered by close of business Friday, March 5, 2010, to Eric Vondy, SHPO/ Arizona State Parks, 1300 W. Washington St., Phoenix AZ 85007. Submissions transmitted via fax or e-mail will not be accepted.
